

CPR/AEDs/FIRST-AID EMPLOYEE TRAINING PROGRAM POLICY

In carrying out its responsibility to make all of its schools and related programs as safe and healthy as possible, the Portsmouth City School Board requires that all of its administrators, health professionals, physical education teachers, and coaches be certified in CPR/AEDs and first aid. At a minimum, all schools must have four staff members certified in CPR/AEDs and first aid. The School Board strongly encourages all of its employees to be certified in CPR/AEDs and first aid. For those employees who are required to hold certification in CPR/AEDs and first aid, the School Board will pay for all costs of that training. The School Board will strive to make this training available to these employees free of cost. The Superintendent will develop regulations for implementing and maintaining this mandatory and voluntary training.
