## CPR/AEDs/FIRST-AID TRAINING PROGRAM REGULATION

June 2004 - Fifty percent of all physical education teachers, coaches, and administrators, and 100 percent of all school nurses will be trained and certified in CPR/AEDs and first aid. A minimum of two staff members will be trained at every school. All other employees are strongly encouraged to become trained and certified in CPR/AEDs and first aid as training capacity is increased. Instructors will be trained TO TEACH CPR/AEDs and first aid in 50 PERCENT of the division's schools. Copies of employees' certificates will be placed in their personnel files. AEDs will be mounted in all high schools.

June 2005 - One hundred percent of all physical education teachers, coaches, and administrators will be trained and certified in CPR/AEDs and first aid. A minimum of four staff members will be trained at every school. All other employees will be strongly encouraged to become trained and certified in CPR/AEDs and first aid. Instructors will be trained to teach CPR/AEDs and first aid in the remaining schools of the division. All physical education teachers will be trained as instructors. Three trainers of instructors will be trained. AEDs will be mounted in all middle schools.

June 2006 - One hundred percent of all physical education teachers, coaches, administrators will maintain their certification in CPR/AEDs and first aid. All other employees will continue to be strongly encouraged to become trained and certified in CPR/AEDs and first aid. Instructors will be trained to teach CPR/AEDs and first aid within the division. Three additional trainers of instructors will be trained. AEDs will be mounted in all elementary schools and other buildings owned by the school division. CPR/AEDs and first-aid training and certification are required for graduation from the Portsmouth Public Schools.
